Hindi is the official language in Jharkhand and is spoken by the majority of the population (61.95%), although different regions have their own dialects. These include **Nagpuri, Khortha, Kurmali, Magahi** and **Bhojpuri**. Jharkhand has accorded second language status to **Angika, Bengali, Bhojpuri, Ho, Kharia, Kurukh, Khortha, Kurmali, Magahi, Maithili, Mundari, Nagpuri, Odia, Santali** and **Urdu**.
