

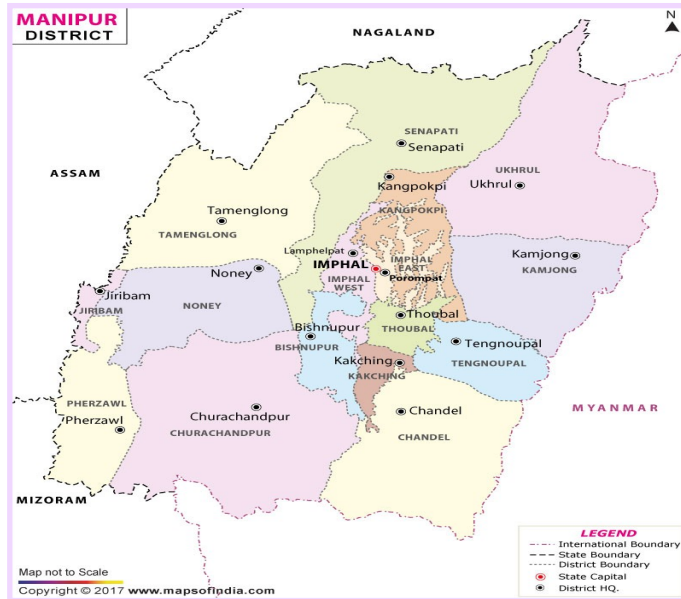

Pictured above are the **16** districts within Manipur. Manipur is a state in northeastern India, with the city of Imphal as its capital. Manipur has a population of 2,855,794 as per 2011 census.

The main language of Manipur is **Meitei** (also known as Manipuri) and **English**, followed closely by **Thadou** language of the Kuki tribe and other various dialects of the Kuki tribes, followed by Naga tribes various dialects. The languages spoken in Manipur are **Meitei, Poula language** (Poumai Naga), **Thadou-Kuki, Tangkhul, Kabui, Paite, Hmar, Vaiphei, Liangmai, Bengali, Hindi, Maring, Anal, Zou, Emeila** (Mao Naga), **Kom, Gangte, Simte, and Mon** (Monsang+Moyon). There are **35** languages
