Pictured above are the **12** districts of Nagaland. The state's population is 1.978 million, out of which 88% are Christians. The census of 2011 recorded the state's Christian population at 1,739,651, making it

Naga languages can be grouped into Western, Central and Eastern groups. The Western group includes (among others) **Angami**, **Chokri** and **Kheza**. The Central group includes **Ao**, **Sumi**, **Lotha** and **Sangtam**, whereas the Eastern group includes **Konyak** and **Chang**. In addition, there are Naga-Bodo group illustrated by **Mikir** language, and **Kuki** group of languages illustrated by **Sopvama** (also called **Mao Naga**) and
